



Resume

- What is it for?
- 1 page
- Overview of your skills, career, interests

How to make?

- LaTex
 - pdflatex, mactex, sharelatex, overleaf
 - latextemplates.com
- Google Docs
- Microsoft Word

- Education
 - University
 - Turing!
 - Your GPA
 - Expected graduation date

- Software skills
 - Languages/technologies you know
 - Usually split into different levels
 - Proficient, work in, etc...

- Experience
 - Previous work experience
 - Company, dates worked, job title, location
 - Short description of what you did
 - Bullet points
 - General enough to understand
 - Start every sentence with verb
 - Use important words (read: buzz words)

- Classes
 - Optional, but common
 - Only put relevant classes
 - Highlight honors courses
 - Can also list if you are mentor/proctor/TA
 - Can also list classes you plan to take

- Projects
 - Very useful for start of interviews
 - Recruiters care what you do in your free time
 - Also put class projects (especially CS314H)

- Interests
 - Don't use more than 1 or 2 lines
 - Can be non-CS related
 - Pokemon? Starcraft? Volleyball?

What else?

- Leadership experience
- Volunteer experience
- Publications/research

What about high school?

- Sorry, but companies don't really care very much
- High school, GPA, rank? maybe
- Don't put test scores
- Some stuff might be significant, but most of it is not
